#YouAreWelcomeHere Scholarship Application

The #YouAreWelcomeHere scholarship recognizes international students who have a vision for enhancing intercultural understanding. Participating institutions will award annual, renewable scholarships covering a minimum of 50% non-resident tuition. The scholarship is open to first year international students admitted for undergraduate degree-seeking study at CSUSM. You must apply to California State University San Marcos ~ International Admissions and submit scholarship application by April 1st.

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a first-year international applicant applying to our university. An international applicant is an individual who holds citizenship in a country outside of the United States and requires a student visa to study in the United States and who does not also possess US citizenship or permanent residency.
- This scholarship is only for one major and no minors, course work covered in scholarship must count towards degree requirements.
- · Attend (or have graduated from) a secondary school outside of the United States.
- · Demonstrate interest and personal initiative in activities involving intercultural learning and exchange.
- Complete a scholarship application (a 500-1000 word essay or 2-5 minute video) use form below describing your aspirations to
 conduct projects, research, employment, or other experiences that will advance intercultural learning.

Application Process

- 1. Apply for admission to CSUSM
- 2. Submit the one-page #YouAreWelcomeHere application to your chosen colleges/universities by April 1 of each year.
- 3. If awarded a scholarship, claim it by submitting an enrollment deposit to CSUSM by May 1 of each year.

Scholarship Maintenance

- · Scholarship can be renewed for up to 4 years (Fall and Spring semesters only).
- Participate in at least 10 hours of cultural sharing and engagement with the local or campus community.
- · Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- · Enroll and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credits per semester

Deadlines

- University application submission: April 1 of each year
- Submit scholarship application: April 1 of each year
- Enrollment Deposit: May 1 of each year

Note: Students applying for January entry may be considered for scholarship *IF* funds are available. Please contact us at intappl@csusm.edu or visit us at csusm.edu/global/admissions for official deadlines for January entry.
