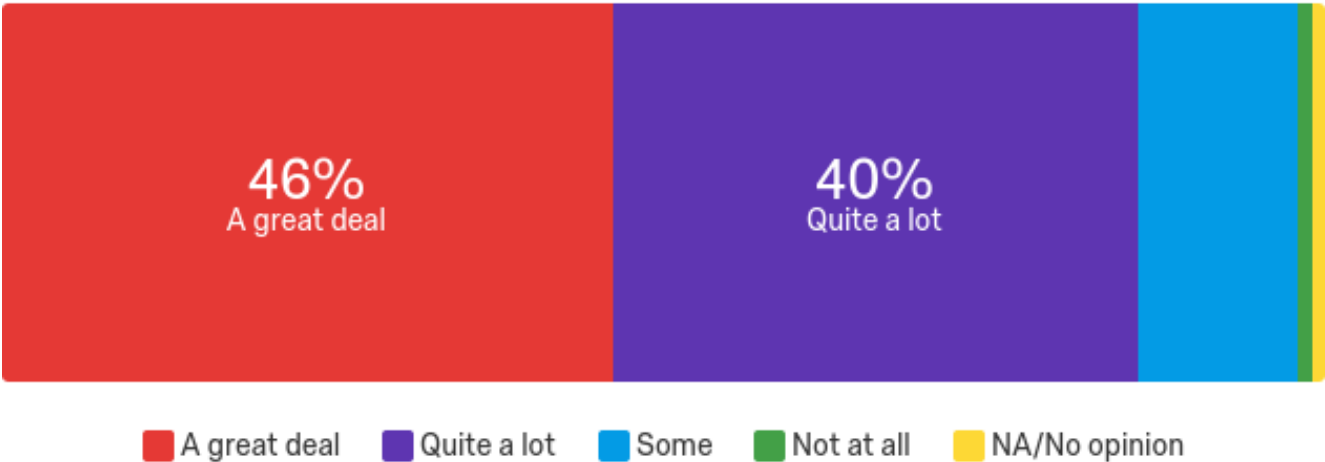

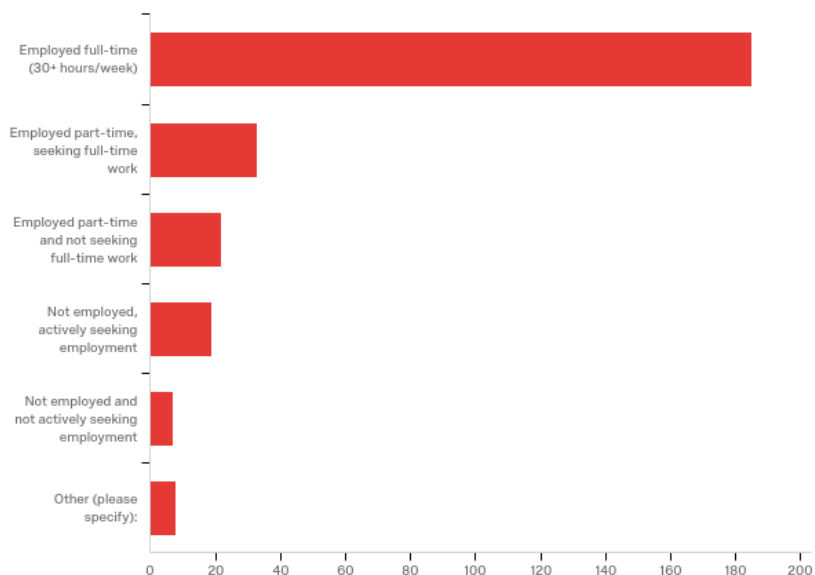

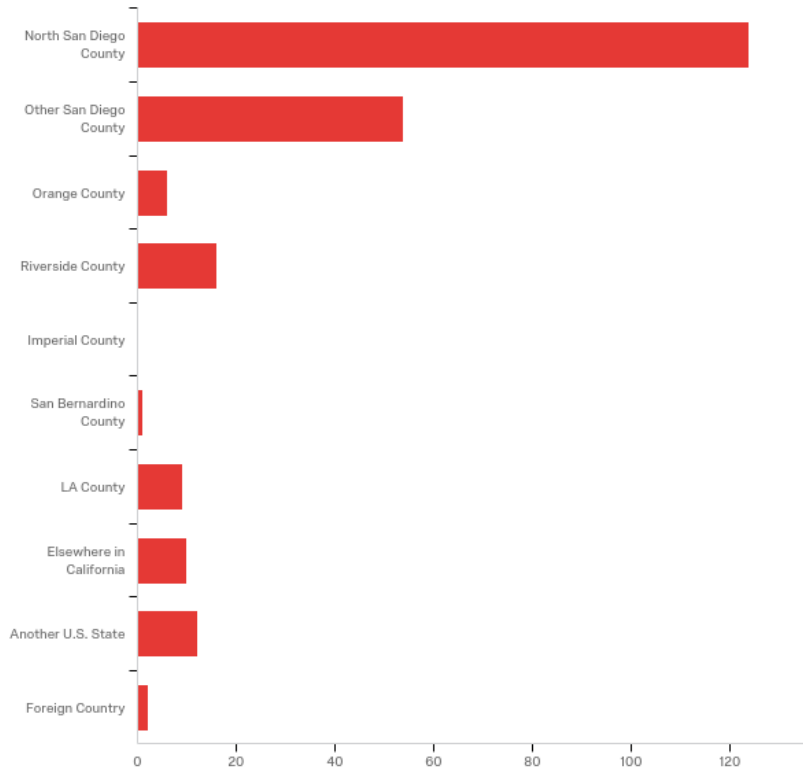

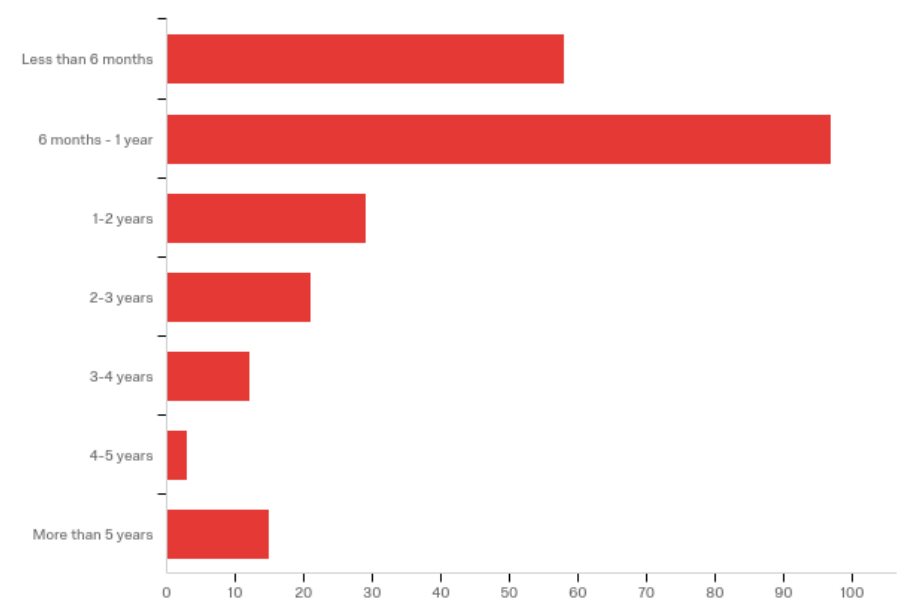

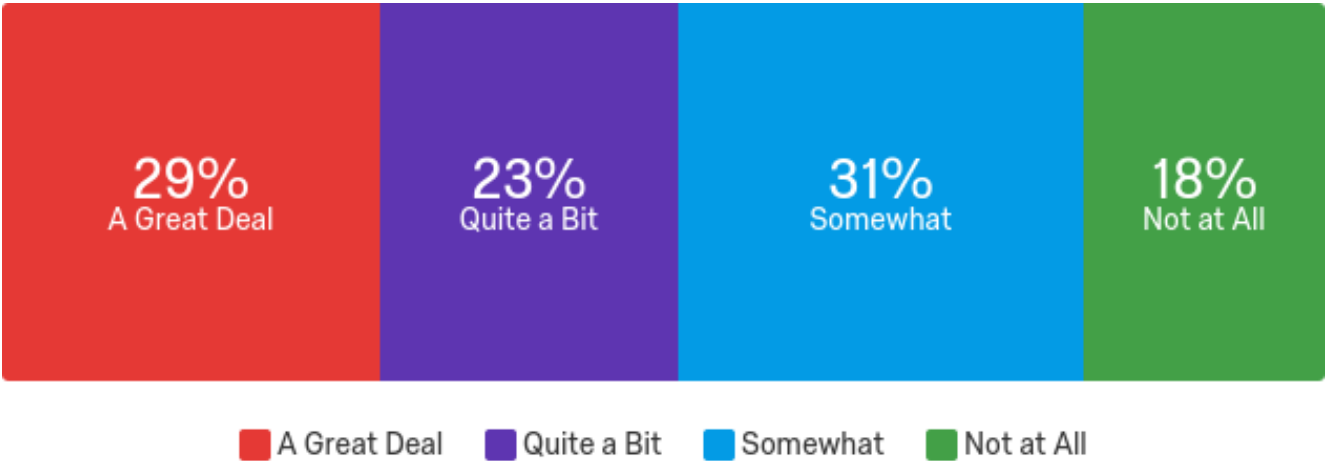

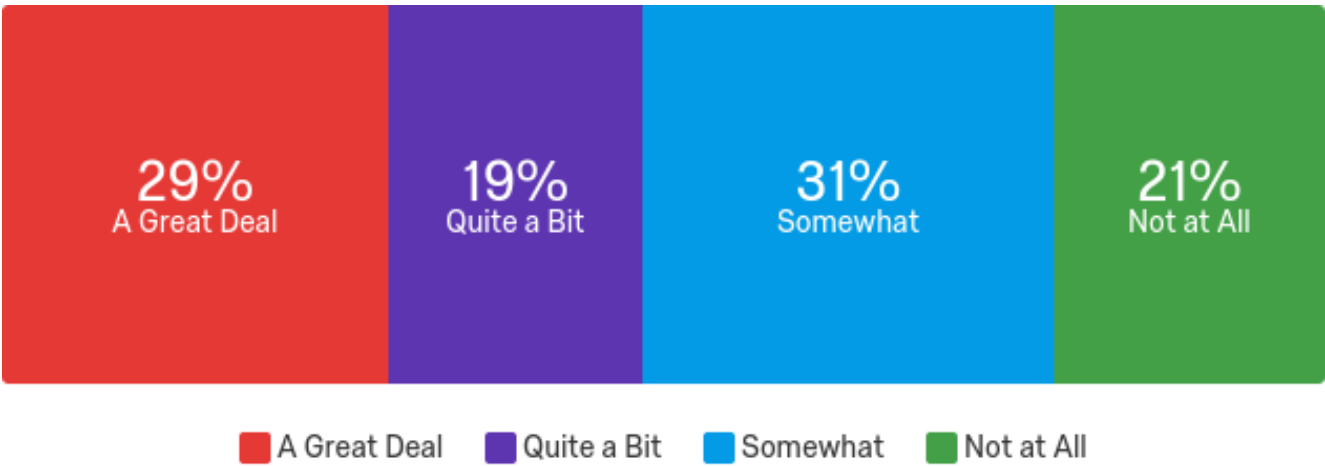

To what degree does your current position align with your career goals?



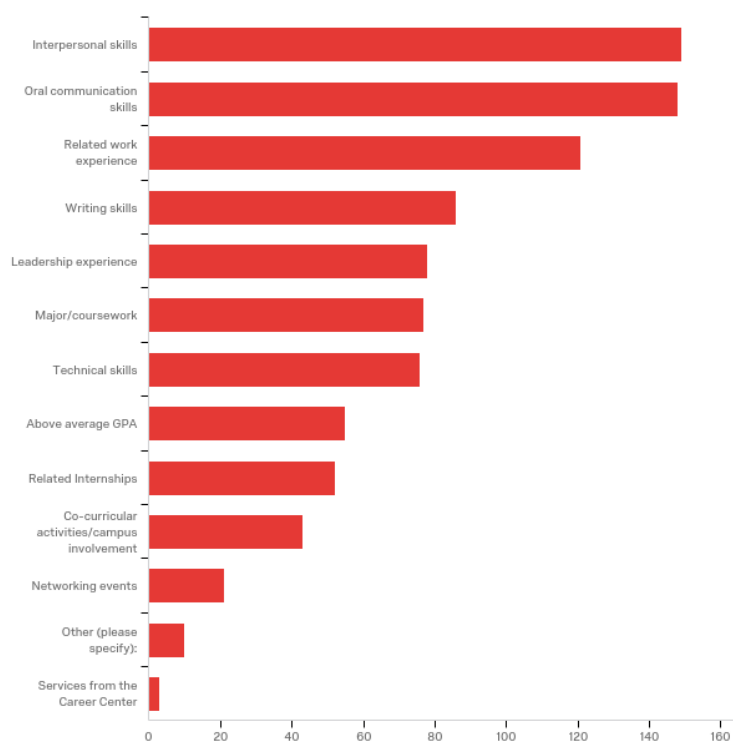

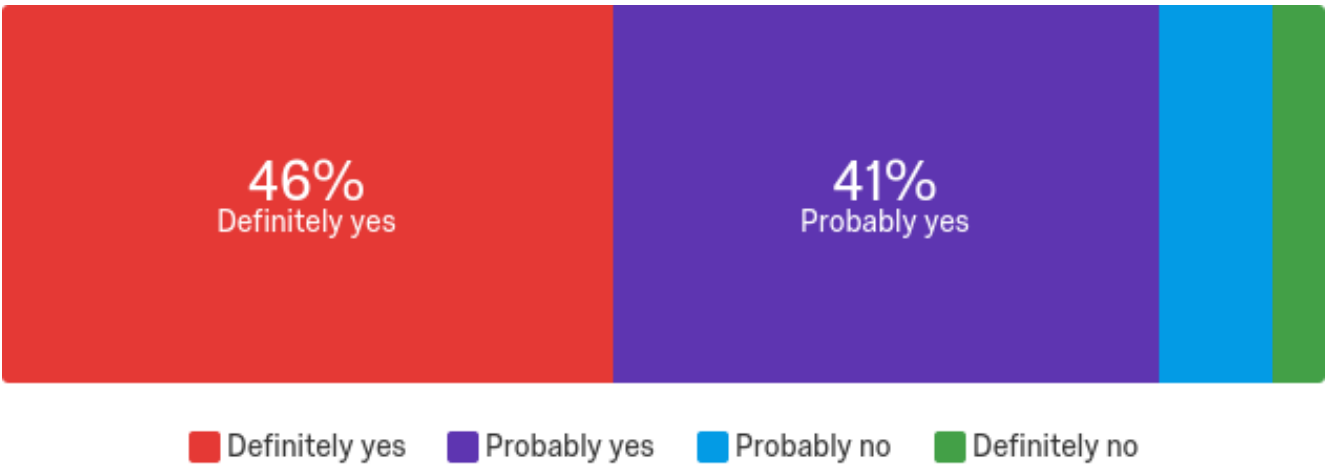

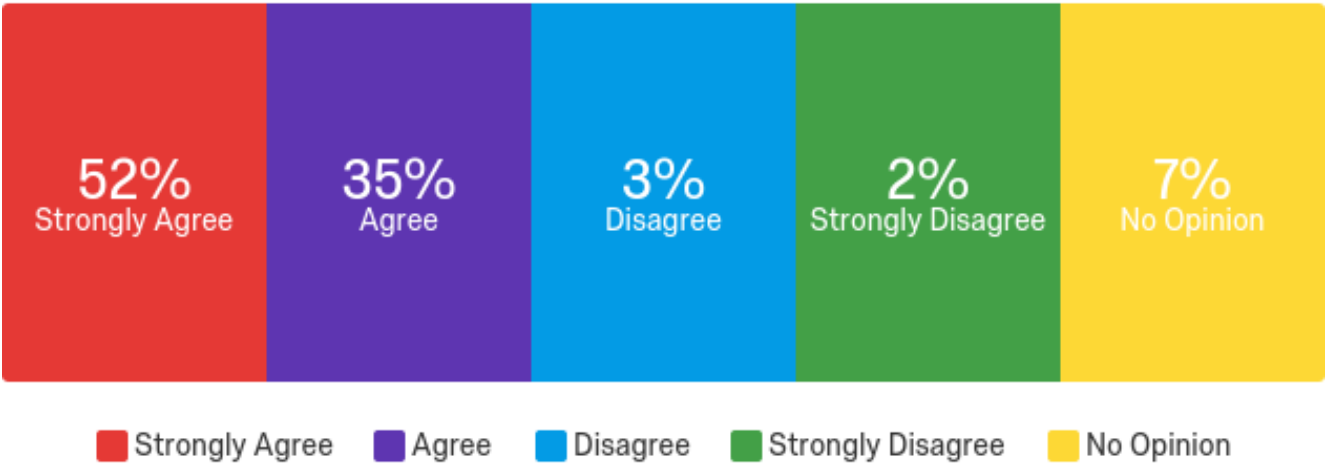
If you could make your college choice over, would you still choose CSUSM?



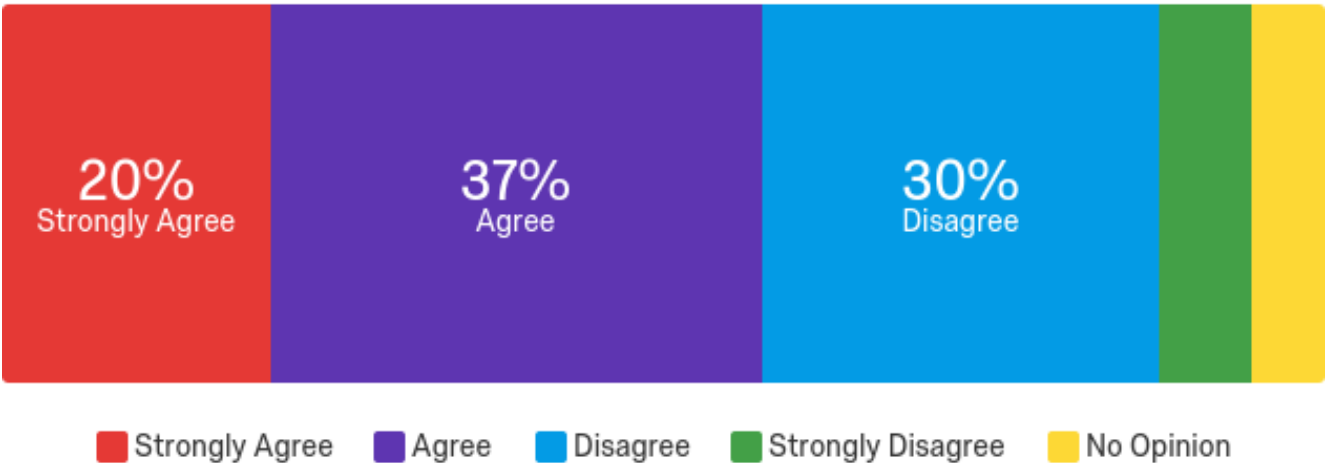

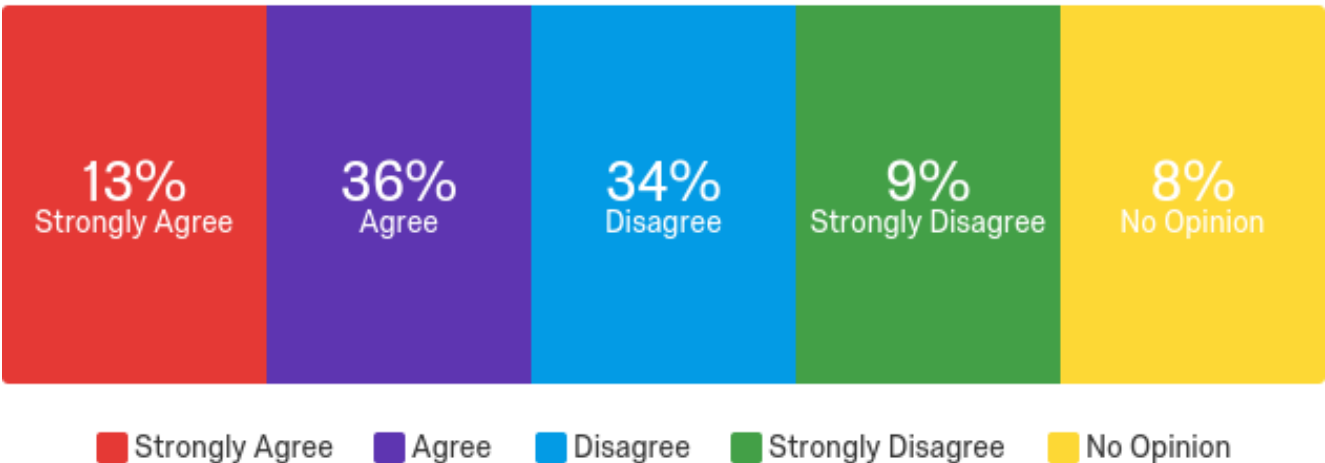

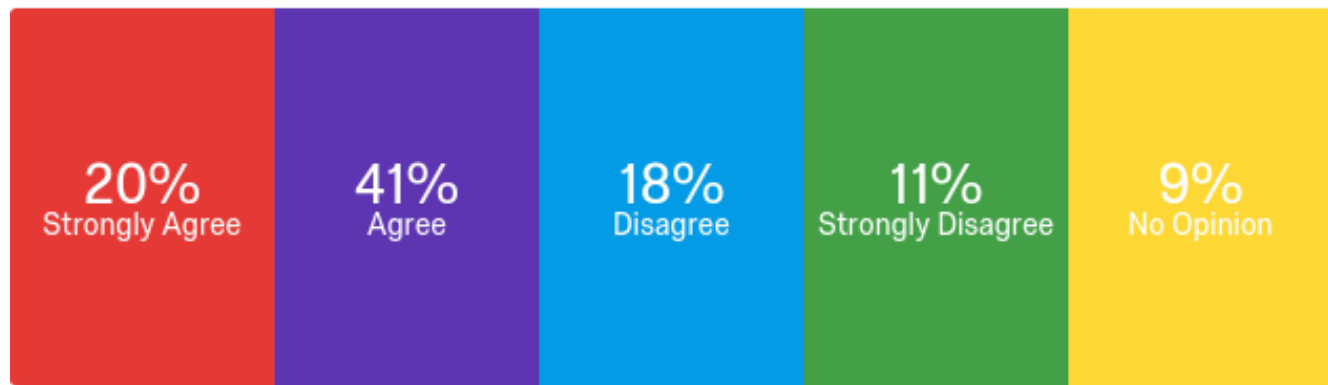

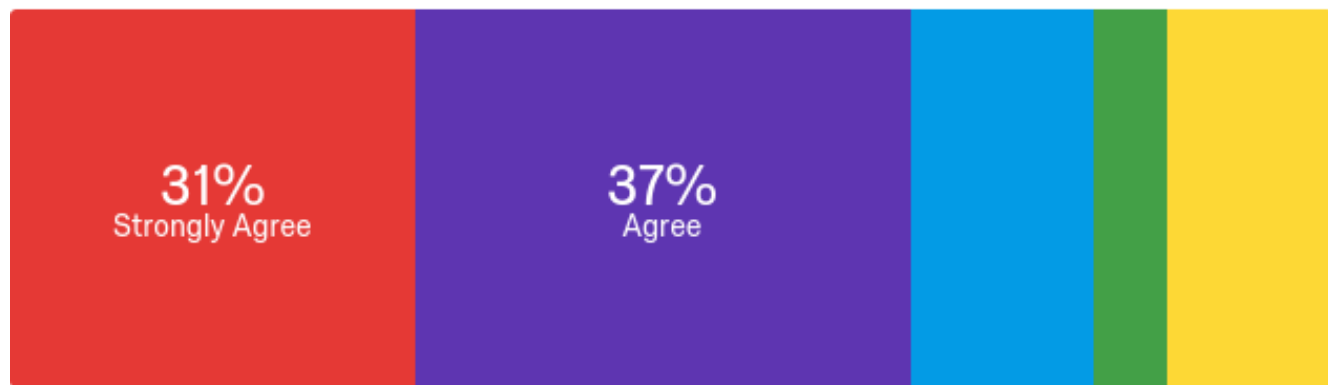

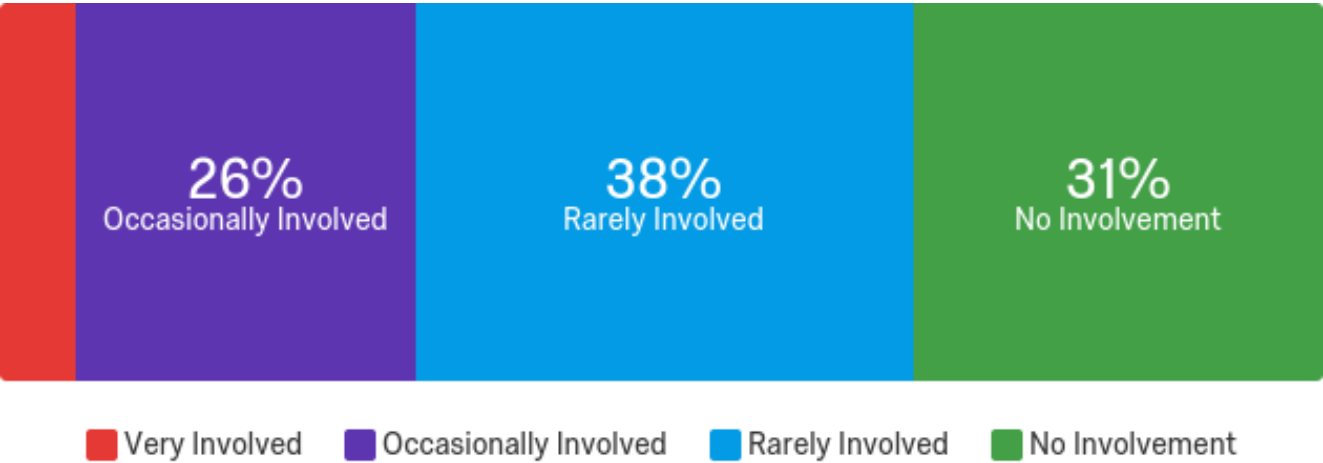

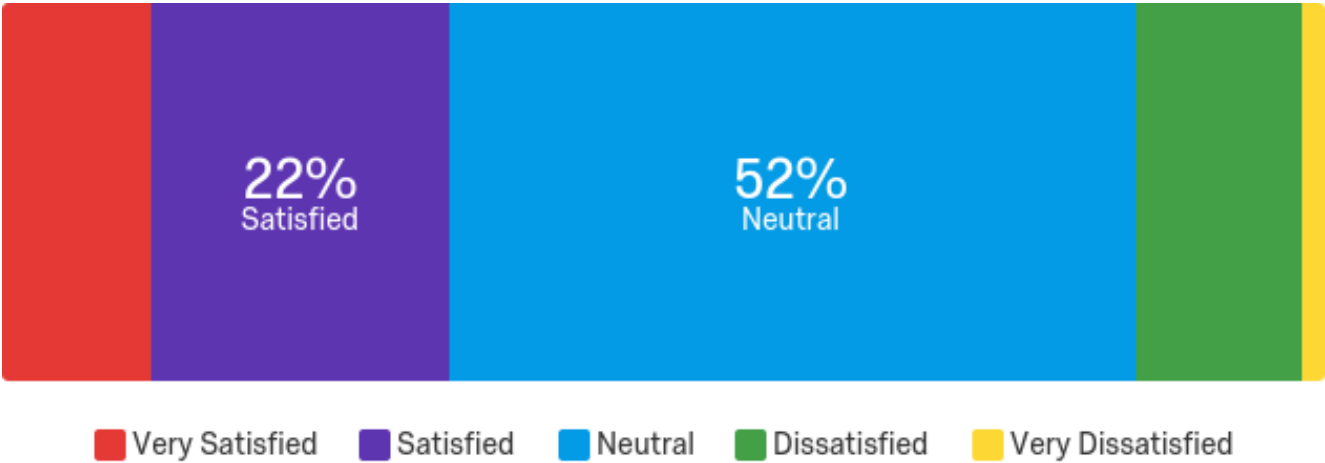
