

Graduation Survey

Enrollment Management Services included a Graduation Survey with all of the diplomas that were mailed to the 2012-2013 graduates. The 2012-2013 graduates included the following terms: Summer 2012, Fall 2012 and Spring 2013. Of the 2391 surveys mailed, 227 were returned. The overall response rate was 9.5%. Among the respondents 92% received their bachelors' degree and 8% received their masters' degree. Graduates were asked what they anticipated their principal activity would be in the next six months. Respondents could select more than one activity. Here are the results:
