

Spring 2020 Graduation Survey Results

The Spring 2020 CSUSM Exit Survey was administered from April 28- June 1, 2020 to all degree and credential seeking students who applied to graduate in Spring/Summer 2020 (n=3313). 2,034 responses were submitted for a 61.4% response rate. All respondents were mailed a CSUSM Commemorative Alumni pin.
