2021 Exit Survey

In Spring 2021 graduating students who applied for Spring or Summer graduation were invited to take the Exit Survey to share their post-graduation plans. Their responses inform initiatives to help current CSUSM students and alumni in their career development.

Employment

*Based off the number of students who responded to the survey

- How many graduates are employed?
 - 27% of graduating students are employed*
- How did employed students find their job?

Graduates who indicated they were employed found their jobs through...

- o 36% a friend, family member, or acquaintance
- o 17% their employers website
- o 16% through a job posting on a career site
- Are employed graduates staying in the San Diego region?
 - 41% North San Diego
 - o 22% Elsewhere in San Diego
 - 11% Riverside County

Continuing Education

*Based off the number of students who responded to the survey

- How many graduating students are pursuing post-graduation programs?
 - 26% are pursuing post-graduate programs: graduate, teaching, or professional preparation programs*
- What programs are graduating students mainly pursuing?
 - 45% Masters
 - o 23% Teaching Credential
 - 11% Doctorate

Internship data points

- How many graduates participated in an internship?
 - 30% participated in an internship
- Were any of those internships paid?
 - 24% of internship participants reported that their internship was paid
- Did their internship help their job search?
 - o 10% of employed respondents found their current job through their internship

Fun Facts

- Top programs of study (as reported by students continuing their education)
 - Education
 - Medical
 - Social Work
 - Speech-Language Pathology
- Of graduates who indicated they are continuing their education...
 - 43% have applied or been accepted at CSUSM
- Of graduates who indicated they were employed...
 - 49% reported they have jobs directly related to their major/field of study
- While at CSUSM...
 - 45% of graduates utilized the career center
