

I. PREAMBLE

Allowing students to take language courses for a grade of Credit/No Credit may encourage students to take more challenging languages – instead of enrolling in courses at levels similar to what they took in high school – if they can enroll in those courses without worrying that this will negatively affect their Grade Point Average (GPA).

II. POLICY

With the exception of language courses taken in fulfillment of the Area C3 requirement, no GE course taken at CSUSM may be taken with a Credit/No Credit option.
