I'm pleased to share that our overall result for the survey was a 70 percent satisfaction rate – up 3 percentage points from 2014, showing positive progress. However, the Honor Roll benchmark for this year's survey is 77 percent. While we are near the benchmark and the results showcase many of our successes as an organization, there is still work to do. We will incorporate the feedback from this year's survey as we continue the process of creating the best workplace possible.
