Most Significant Contributions to Promote Diversity

- Dr. Morton was P.I. or Co-P.I. on two research grants, both involved American Indian populations in California. Dr. Morton also serves as Founder and Chair of the Indian Health Council, Inc. Institutional Review Board which reviews research proposals for tribal communities in So. CA. In this capacity, Dr. Morton is a Co-PI on the California Native American Research Center in Health (CA-NARCH) funded continuously by Indian Health Service and NIH (NIGMS) since 2001.
- Dr. Morton worked for many years at UCSD for the LGBT Resource Center on campus, the largest center of its kind on any public university campus in the country. She volunteered at the Center and served on the Advisory Board when she was UCSD staff and has continued working with the Center after becoming faculty in 2000. Dr. Morton served on the Advisory Board for the LGBT Resource Center and on the Scholarship Committee (2004-2011). Dr. Morton concentrated on efforts to expand and evolve the scholarship program for UCSD LGBT students. Currently there are six scholarships awarded to LGBT students every year during Rainbow Graduation, one of which Dr. Morton oversees and two of which she assists with fundraising. These scholarships are very helpful to UCSD LGBT students who have to fund their UCSD education because they may have been disowned or cut-off from financial support by their families due to their LGBT status. Dr. Morton was awarded the UCSD Chancellor's Campus-wide

Diversity Award in 2005.
