





# **Fulfilled-Category 1**

Student has met the CSU GE Breadth Subarea A2 and/or B4 requirement via Advanced Placement (AP) examination, International Baccalaureate (IB) examination or transferable course.

# **Ready-Category 2**

Student has met examination standards and/or multiple measures-informed standards.

# **Ready with support and optional participation in Early Start-Category 3**

Based on new multiple measures, student needs additional academic support. Participation in the Early Start Program is recommended and may be highly advisable for some students, particularly STEM majors. **Ready with support and required participation in Early Start-Category 4** Based on new multiple measures, student needs additional academic support. Participation in the Early Start Program is required.

Early Start 2023

Early Start is no longer required for incoming freshmen. It is still recommended for students in Category 3 and Category 4. Every CSU campus has their own Early Start program.



A tuition waiver pool will be available to provide financial support for students attending the summer phases before and/or at the end first academic year of their first matriculated term for Supportive Pathways for First-Year Students instruction.



Classes will begin at the end of June. Classes range from 3-6 weeks for English and math. Students will be notified via email. We can come to your school to register your students for Early Start
