## **Key Points on Math at CSU San Marcos**

- Mathematics is creative, vibrant, and active! There is new math being created and new math research happening constantly.
- Studying mathematics gives you a unique perspective and logical toolkit.
  You can use mathematical tools on all sorts of interesting problems inside and outside math research.
- One of the biggest factors impeding student success is a lack of fluency in fundamental mathematical ideas. Students need to understand concepts like fractions, functions, and manipulating both sides of an equality with algebra.
- These concepts need to click. Students who have a deep understanding of these relatively basic concepts have the foundation to do very well in STEM.
  - CSU San Marcos is focused on student success. There are a plethora of programs in place to support students. The support system is vast; however, we have a student-centered office to help students navigate and get the support they need.
  - The math major has just diversified into four different tracks: General, Education, Applied, and Algorithmic. These tracks help students specialize to be prepared for their post-graduation goals!
