#### Recap

- ASI BOD has passed 4 resolutions.
- Conducted 2 campus wide surveys that addressed areas of concern with parking and campus climate related to food insecurity and homelessness, which both resulted in a food pantry resolution and proposal and lowering the summer parking permits for student assistants.
- Worked with Student Affairs to initiate an Alcohol Policy Task Force to look into our campus' alcohol policy to extend privileges to student events (e.g. Homecoming) and put in place structures to mitigate risks and implement best practices.
- Total of 11 in district and out of district lobby visits that encouraged our representatives to reestablish the year around Pell grant, fund an additional 101 million of state funding to the CSU, and support legislation that directly impacts our campus.
- Almost tripled our percentage of voter turnout for ASI Board of Director elections.
- Registered over 200 students to vote in our upcoming primary and general elections and still growing.
- Have hosted and co-sponsored over 120 events and programs that furthered our mission in serving, engaging, and empowering students.
