#### Handling a Disclosure of Sexual Misconduct

Inform the person you are not a confidential resource and offer to connect to a confidential advocate or therapist.

Pile a report to Title IX
Office either by phone or email. Keep the person's information private.

Keep the survivor's needs and feelings at the center of the process. Pay attention to your body language and do not touch without asking.

Explain resources and options available on or off campus.

Remember it is not your role to investigate. Listen to the survivor respectfully and believe the survivor.
