Students and employees can speak with a Sexual Violence Advocate in a confidential environment to learn about their options and rights.

Reports will NOT automatically lead to a legal or Title IX report.

Services are available to all CSUSM students and employees and include:

ACCOMPANIMENT

Police interviews
Legal meetings
Court
University Title IX

SUPPORT OFFERED

An advocate will be there to offer emotional and logistics support, listen without judgement, and respect your decisions.

ACADEMIC INTERVENTION

If your academics are negatively impacted due to a recent or past trauma, we can assist you with initiating an academic intervention with your professors and/or the University.



Two key responses that have positive effect on survivors: (1) Being believed, and (2) Having someone to talk to

REFERRALS & RESOURCES

We can provide resources and referrals for safety planning, housing, concerned loved ones, on- and off-campus resources, requests for restraining orders or no contact orders, reporting options, and support groups.

Prevention & Education

We offer a variety of innovative initiatives to educate and build awareness on complex issues related to stalking, sexual harassment, dating/domestic violence, sexual assault and rape.

Through training and education, students, faculty, and staff learn how they can prevent sexual violence and promote bystander intervention.
