## MASTER OF SCIENCE IN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY IN-PERSON AND HYBRID OPTIONS

The Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology prepares students for the full scope of practice in the field of speech-language pathology. After successfully completing the program, graduates will be eligible for state licensure, CTC credentialing to practice in California public schools, and national (ASHA-CCC) certification.

- How to describe the nature of typical and disordered communication and swallowing across the lifespan
- How to integrate theory, research and evidence-based principles into prevention, assessment and intervention practices
- How to interact and communicate in ways that promote wellness and reflect respect for diversity, collaboration and ethics
- How to demonstrate summative knowledge and skills necessary for entry-level practice within the field of speech-language pathology through defense of a culminating experience

This is a cohort-based degree program that can be completed in as few as five semesters, including summer. In-person and hybrid options are available. The program reinforces classroom knowledge using simulated experiences in a new state-of-the-art simulation theater. In addition, specialty clinics maximize student experience and include 400 supervised hours in community-based practice to prepare participants for their career in speech-language pathology.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in speech and hearing sciences and/or disorders as well as other course requirements, or bachelor's degree in any field with specific prerequisite courses (see website for details)
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 in last 60 units completed
- All applicants, regardless of citizenship, who do not possess a bachelor's degree from a post-secondary institution where English is the principal language must satisfy the English-language proficiency requirement
