The Bachelor of Science in Speech-Language Pathology provides a broad education covering content related to speech, language, communication and cognitive and swallowing disorders across the lifespan. Upon graduation, students can confidently apply to graduate programs in speech-language pathology or pursue further education and opportunities in a number of fields and professions, including general and special education, human development, social work, public health, communication and cognitive science.

- How to explain the development of communication functions and their breakdown across the lifespan
- How to synthesize knowledge across disciplines, including statistics, basic science, behavioral science and humanities, and apply it to speech-language pathology
- How to describe the speech, language, communication and swallowing disorders that are diagnosed and treated by speech-language pathologists
- How to develop a comprehensive understanding of SLP, including biological, neurological, psychological, developmental and cultural aspects

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 45 CSU transferable units
- 2.0 minimum cumulative GPA in all transferable units attempted
- Successful completion of the Golden Four courses: English Composition, Critical Thinking, Oral Communication, and Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning
- Completion of the majority of lower-division general education requirements; applicants can be missing no more than three lower-division courses needed to meet general education and/or graduation requirements
- Spring (online) applicants must reside in an approved state (see website for details)
