The Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology prepares you for the full scope of practice in the field of speech-language pathology. After successfully completing the program, you will be eligible for California SLP licensure, CTC credentialing to practice in California public schools, and national (ASHA-CCC) certification.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in speech and hearing sciences and/or disorders as well as other course requirements, or bachelor's degree in any field with specific prerequisite courses (see website for details)
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 in last 60 units completed
- All applicants, regardless of citizenship, who do not possess a bachelor's degree from a post-secondary institution where English is the principal language must satisfy the English-language proficiency requirement
- Online students must reside in the state of California
