

FALL 2022 MS SLP APPLICATION: STEP 1 INSTRUCTIONS

YOUR CAL STATE APPLY APPLICATION (Required)

Please review all instructions on this document **BEFORE** starting the application. You will need unofficial copies of your transcripts to complete this application.

- A. Click the following application link; <https://calstate.liaisoncas.com/applicant-ux/#/login>
- B. First time users, click the "Create an Account" link and follow the instructions to create your account. **Be sure to write down your username and password to use at a later time.**
- C. Update the "Complete Your Profile" webpage with your specific information and click the **Save Changes** button.
- D. You will be directed to the next screen titled **Add Programs**.
 1. In the search bar, type in the city of the campus **San Marcos** and hit enter.
 2. Scroll down to find **Master of Science - Speech-Language Pathology - Fall**.
 3. Select the **+** sign to add the program to your application and click on **Continue**.
- E. You will be directed to **Review Your Program Selections**. Click the **Continue to My Application** link.
