A total of 2 pages max.

Part Five – Video Prompts

You will be uploading 2 separate Personal Videos as part of this supplemental application. **Your videos are to be a maximum of 2 minutes each in length.** Once you have prepared your response, follow the instructions to record the video and upload to YouTube using Option 1 or 2. **Responses should be natural and not recited or read.**

Record/Upload Option 1 - Using your cell phone and YouTube: Use the recording software on your cell phone to record your response. When finished, you will upload this file to YouTube. Make sure the setting on YouTube enables the video to be viewed by others (i.e., make sure the URL is accessible). Please account for the amount of time that it will take to upload the video. Check the recording to make sure it is working before submitting.

Record/Upload Option 2 - Using Zoom and YouTube: This method requires both a webcam/microphone and a YouTube account. Create a free Zoom account here: <https://www.zoom.us>. Click on "Host a Meeting - With Video on." Then click "Join Audio by Computer." Before you start, be sure the microphone and video are both working in the lower left corner of the Zoom program. When you are ready, click "Record," and end by clicking "Stop Recording." You will then click "End Meeting for All." Your recording will automatically be saved on your computer. Locate the file titled "zoom_0." You will upload this file to YouTube. The same caution applies with respect to the amount of time needed to upload.

Once you are done, make sure the setting on YouTube enables the video to be viewed by others (i.e., make sure the URL is accessible). Please account for the amount of time it will take to upload the video. Check the recording to make sure it is working before submitting. Video Prompt #1
