Seminars

- Three seminars are required
- Seminars are 500- or 600-level MASP courses.
- One seminar is offered each semester
- Certain seminars (SOC 516, SOC 518, SOC 616, SOC 618) may be taken up to two times for a total of four units if both offerings offer a different class theme.
- If permission is given by the graduate committee and class instructor, students may:
 - take one 400-level undergraduate sociology course in lieu of a graduate-level seminar. The class chosen needs to be four units and must not be a course taken as an undergraduate. This will typically be on your schedule as Soc 698: Independent Study for two units, if more than two units adjust the table below accordingly.
 - or students can take one 600-level independent study course in lieu of a graduate-level seminar. This will typically be on your schedule as Soc 698: Independent Study for two units, if more than two units adjust the table below accordingly.

Culminating Experience Courses

- You will enroll with the instructor of record, but work closely with your chair on your CE
- Both SOC 690 and SOC 695 are graded as Credit/No Credit
- For SOC 690: Culminating Experience Proposal Preparation
 - Prerequisites: SOC 500, SOC 515, SOC 530, SOC 550, and SOC 560
 - May be taken for three semesters for a total of 12 units of proposal preparation.
- For SOC 695: Culminating Experience
 - Enrollment Requirement: Advancement to Candidacy (complete CE Proposal Defense with all revisions accepted by your committee).
 - Prerequisites: SOC 500, SOC 515, SOC 530, SOC 550, and SOC 560
 - You may take SOC 695 only once. If you need to continue working on your CE, you can enroll in SOC 699: Culminating Experience Extension, which can be taken up to three times (totaling 12 additional units). Feel free to update the table below as needed.
