



Director's Message

In 2015, the California State University system embarked on an ambitious proposal entitled, "Graduation Initiative 2025: Improving student success through innovation and strategic thinking". Using proactive strategies, each campus was

tasked with substantially increasing the percentage of students who completed their degrees in 4 - 6 years for first year students and 2 - 4 years for transfer students over the next ten years. CSUSM set in motion various approaches to address the obstacles that contributed to lower graduation rates, and which prevented their students from completing undergraduate degrees in a timely manner.

Implementing a program that strives to reach higher graduation goals among its students is something that TRIO programs have done well for decades. For TRIO programs, the objectives that we set in our grants are not only ambitious but also attainable based on data which clearly demonstrates that our services meet the needs of traditionally disadvantaged students. Because of this success, TRIO SSS at CSUSM has continually shown that we were up to the challenge of increasing our rates.

However, in March 2020, the Covid-19 pandemic forced most classes, services, and programming across campus to quickly pivot to online platforms. Even though no one anticipated the additional challenges this would bring to helping students persist and graduate, TRIO SSS once again found innovative ways to adjust our approaches to reach our students. We learned to navigate a new world of education alongside our students.

As a result, I am pleased to report that TRIO SSS at CSUSM met and surpassed the mid-point goals for 2021 that had been originally set by the CSU Graduation Initiative in 2015 as evidenced in the chart below. Through continued innovation, we are confident that we will surpass the 2025 goals as well.
