Memorandum of Understanding with California State University San Marcos

Expanded Educational Opportunities for Tribal Communities: An MOU can create pathways for students to access higher education, including admissions support, scholarships, mentorship programs, internship opportunities, and academic success resources.

Comprehensive Student Success Support: Students receive dedicated support through success coaching, academic advising, career counseling, enrollment assistance, internship and employment preparation, and access to campus student success resources.

Access to American Indian Focused Programs and Resources: Students benefit from services offered through the Nest (American Indian Student Center) and the California Indian Culture and Sovereignty Center (CICSC), which promote academic achievement, cultural engagement, retention, and graduation.

College Readiness and Outreach for Tribal Communities: CSUSM commits to ongoing recruitment and outreach activities, including presentations, workshops, college and career readiness programming, campus visits, and exploration of dual enrollment opportunities for tribal students.
